# Holistic Child & Youth Development Program

## Survival and Early Childhood Interventions

The survival component of our program focuses on the health and survival of mothers and babies during the most vulnerable time of the baby's life — prenatal through age one.

## Child and Youth Development programming

Our work is to facilitate a network of caring individuals to protect and enable positive development in children and youth who live in poverty based on a holistic approach to child and youth development with four outcome areas:

**Capacity For Economic Self-Sufficiency:** Motivation, skills, and education to support themselves and others economically.

**Youth Agency:** Having vision, skills, and character to influence their context positively.

**Spiritual Development:** Growing in their spiritual relationships and contributing to and engaging with the community.

**Well-Being:** Being physically and mentally healthy and having a positive self-identity and relationships.



## Complementary Interventions

Complementary Interventions provide a wide range of opportunities to engage in the fight against poverty, provide preventive care, and address various other needs that may arise for Compassion's participants and require funding beyond what monthly sponsorship can provide.

### Examples include:

- Disaster response
- Medical Assistance
- Water, sanitation, & hygiene (WaSH) interventions
- Highly vulnerable children's care
- Vocational, technical, or university training
